The following details relate to an excursion to the Australian Parliament House for students in Year 4. The focus of the excursion is to participate in a variety of activities based on our knowledge unit relating to democracy. The staff at Parliament are preparing a fun filled day of learning for all Year 4 Lyneham students. These activities will be split into three sessions. Session I will be a guided tour; sessions II a roleplay activity and session III will consist of a hospitality get together.

Dates/time: Monday, 25th November 2024 (Week 7, Term 4)

Purpose of excursion: To participate in a variety of hands-on activities relating democracy and parliament.

Clothing and Equipment: School Uniform, a small bag to take a freshly cut lunch and bottle of water. It is

recommended all students label their bag with their name.
